

Round 2 – Autumn Sunday Cup

A full grid of drivers took part in this Sunday's second round of the Bayford Meadows Sunday Cup. A good split of youth and experience meant we were in for a cracking race.

A few dark clouds were looming over Bayford as the first race began. Joe Hunt qualified on pole position and was uncatchable throughout the first race as he stormed to a victory by 8 clear seconds. James Tomsett was second, closely followed by James Barnard. In fourth was Terry White, who was the highest placed heavyweight driver. Phil Lowe and James Fermer were fifth and sixth respectively.

The drivers began the second race with rain imminent and the wet weather soon had a large impact on proceedings. James Tomsett showed great control and skill in the difficult conditions to get out in front and attempt to close the gap that Hunt had opened up on him in the first race. Terry White showed his wealth of experience, following closely behind Tomsett and ensuring he was the top Heavyweight driver of the afternoon. Joe Hunt held his nerve and managed to finish third, just 5 seconds behind Tomsett that meant he was going to be our overall winner in the lightweight class.

After the results were put together, Terry White was the clear winner in the heavyweight class, James Fermer was second, and third was Paul Campbell. Hunt won the lightweight class, closely followed by Tomsett, and James Barnard came third.
